Keep in view that teacher's evaluation by students is an important part of education system for better development and performance of teacher in an institution as well for better growth, understanding and teaching-learning process by students, Administration of CNB College always tries to conduct confidential survey among the students for each and every individual teachers periodically.

Due to the outburst of Second wave of Covid-19 pandemic education system was adversely affected again due to the lockdown imposed by the government in response to Covid-19. College was closed up to 1st October, 2020. Although college was closed but to compensate the loss of physical classes college authority CNB College provided online classes to the students so that there should not be any hinder in education process. Teachers were regularly taken online classes and adopted new methods of digital teaching and learning methods. From 6th November 2020 offline classes were started.

For the session 2020-21 Teachers evaluation was done by online method on dated 14/12/2021 and Google form was circulated to the students through their respective mail and link provided to student groups. The questionnaires were intended to collect information relation to student's satisfaction towards the Library, Administration and Curriculum, Faculties etc.

Three forms were prepared by the feedback monitoring committee viz.

- 1. FORM A for Library, Administration and Curriculum.
- 2. FORM B for faculty members of all the departments and
- 3. Form C for Computer science, N.S.S. and English as these subjects are choice based.

After thorough evaluation of each and every feedback forms against each individual teacher, the evaluation committee has discussed the same with the teacher personally and asked to improve

on the parameters where student satisfaction level was not up to the mark. The questionnaires are attached with the report as documentation for further such kind of survey and progress of individual teachers on next survey.
